From 1908 the college was based on the top floor of the Municipal College, now Park Building. It moved to purpose-built premises in Hyde Park Road (now Eldon Building, Winston Churchill Avenue) in 1960, phase 1 of the building opening on 2 November 1960. By 1993 the College also operated from the John Pounds, Omega Street and Grove Road Centres as well as studios in St Paul's Road.

The college was one of seven federated institutions in the Southern College of Art from 1937 to 1952.

In 1965, architecture courses transferred to Portsmouth College of Technology. This was followed by the transfer of the Dip. A. D. course in Fine Art (a course of degree standard with about 90 students) to the newly established Portsmouth Polytechnic in 1969.

The college merged with the University of Portsmouth on 1 August 1994, and became the Portsmouth School of Art, Design and Media.

Student accommodation was available in Beddow Hall, St Paul's Road Southsea, named after Chairman of the Board of Governors Alderman F. Beddow.
